

Instructions for Applying Sail Numbers

The sail numbers should be black and measure 300mm x 200mm except for the number 1.

Start with the sail starboard side up (with the leech on your left as shown in the diagram). Draw the starboard base line and the starting line in pencil. These lines are parallel to the 2nd top batten and the leech respectively. Align the first number with the base line and the starting line. Leave a 60mm space between each number as you work from left to right.

Once finished on the starboard side flip the sail over and do the same on the port side, working away from the leech (right to left). Remember to put the numbers on in the reverse order as you are working backwards.

Tips

-If the sail has been used wipe it down with a damp soapy cloth and dry it thoroughly to help the numbers adhere.

-To avoid bubbles and creases when sticking on the numbers peel and fold back about 10mm of the sticker backing from the bottom of the number. Place the number into its position and stick it down with the exposed 10mm strip. Slowly peel the rest of the backing off as you stick down the number removing any air bubbles as you go.
